To assist your child's current teacher/s and the school in the student placement process, we invite parents and carers to communicate important information you would like us to consider. Class teachers have the main role in organising students into classes as they have come to know your child and their needs during the year.

***Please note** that requests for your child to be placed with a particular teacher or in a particular class (single year level or composite) cannot be considered. Friendships are considered but need to be supportive of your child and his or her learning and social development. Teachers look at the whole picture of group and class dynamics.*

In deciding where each child will be placed we take into account the following criteria:

- *Teacher knowledge of*
 - *student achievement*
 - *learning needs*
 - *group dynamics*
 - *supportive and unsupportive friendships*
- *Previous settings*
- *Gender balance (where possible)*
- *Enrolment numbers*
- *Any relevant additional information from parents and carers included on this form*

If there are **significant** difficulties, a member of the leadership team will contact you during the placement process. The final decision about placement remains with the school and once we have finalised classes there are usually no adjustments unless our enrolment numbers significantly change affecting the overall number of classes.
