FLUTES OF FLEURIEU (FoF) in 2019

Middle Years Flute Ensemble

Flutes of Fleurieu (FOF) is an Instrumental Music (IM) Middle Years Flute Ensemble established in 2009.

The purpose of the ensemble is to provide Year 5 to Year 9, SA government school students with the opportunity to extend their musical and technical skills, and perform in a range of concerts.

This ensemble consists of 10 to 15 players and offers access to Alto and Bass flutes and the piccolo.

Entry to the ensemble is by audition. FoF aims to foster a love and understanding of music, develop skills in ensemble playing and reading music notation, and facilitates the building of friendships with other flute players from a broad cross-section of schools.

Members are required to:

- attend a weekly rehearsal at Adelaide High School, West Terrace, Adelaide on Wednesdays 4.30pm to 6.00pm, commencing term 1, week 3, 2019
- participate in rehearsals and performances
- learn the music for rehearsals and performances and seek assistance from individual instrumental teachers where necessary
- make a positive contribution to the entire team

Audition Dates:

Auditions will be held at Adelaide High School Music Room, West Terrace, Adelaide (See map):


Wednesdays 4.30pm to 6.00pm on one of the following dates:

- Wednesday 5 December 2018, **OR**
- Wednesday, 30 January, 2019

Applicants must book their audition date at least one week in advance.

Audition Requirements:

Applicants will be asked to present the following:

1. **Scales: to be played ♩ = 60 – 80**
 - Any major scale of your choice, ascending and descending in one breath
 - Any major scale of your choice with 3 or more sharps or flats in the key signature
 - A chromatic scale descending to the lowest note in your range.
2. **Two pieces of the student's own choice** that demonstrate technical and musical ability at their current level, considering these elements:
 - Performed unaccompanied
 - Each piece should be at least one minute in length
 - Pieces should be contrasting in style and/or tempo, register, rhythm, etc and reflect the student's current standard of playing
3. **Sight Reading**; which will be provided at the audition
4. Remember to print, complete and bring an **Application Form** with you to the audition (available online at the above address)

Duration of each audition is approximately 10 minutes.

Students enrolled at a SA government school and learning from department instrumental teachers or private tutors are eligible and encouraged to audition.

Students must be in Years 5 to 9 in 2019 to be eligible.

Costs:

Membership cost for Flutes of Fleurieu is \$55 per year (incl. G.S.T. – invoiced after commencement of rehearsals).
