# PRIMARY SCHOOLS GUITAR ENSEMBLE (PSGE) in 2019

The South Australian Primary Schools Guitar Ensemble (PSGE) was formed in 1987 and provides a valuable opportunity for young classical guitarists, normally restricted to solo performance, to experience playing with other musicians.



PSGE performs regularly as a guest artist in many different settings, including some of the major performance venues in Adelaide. They present music in a variety of styles, selected to suit the specific nature of the instrument.

Entry to the ensemble is by audition.

#### Members are required to:

- attend a weekly rehearsal at Highbury Primary School, Corner Honeysuckle Drive and Payne St, Hope Valley, Wednesdays, 3.45pm to 5.15pm commencing in week 6, term 1, 2019
- participate in rehearsals and performances
- learn the music for rehearsals and performances and seek assistance from individual instrumental teachers where necessary
- make a positive contribution to the ensemble

# **Audition Requirements:**

Applicants will be asked to present the following:

- 3 one octave scales, including a chromatic scale (it is suggested that a variety of scales are demonstrated (EG: major or minor, flat or sharp keys)
- One piece of your choice that demonstrates technical and musical ability at your current level (unaccompanied
- 'Waltz' by Daniel Fortea available on the website above

PSGE Applicants are expected to have reasonable mastery of the following techniques:

- rest stroke (apoyando)
- free stroke (tirando)
- arpeggios (pimami)
- block chords (pima)
- half barres
- upward slurs
- downward slurs

Duration of each audition is approximately 10 minutes.

#### **Audition Requirements continued:**

All applicants must perform on classical nylon string guitars, using finger style technique. Steel string acoustic and electric guitars and plectrum technique are not acceptable for this ensemble.

Students enrolled at a SA government school and learning from department instrumental teachers <u>or</u> private tutors are eligible and encouraged to audition.
