Audition Requirements:

- duration of each audition is 10 minutes
- students auditioning should attend a SA government school and be in years
 5, 6 or 7 in 2019
- students learning from department instrumental teachers or private tutors, are eligible and encouraged to audition
- the standard required is that of beyond beginner level

Applicants will be asked to present the following:

- 1. Scales: All to be played from memory.
- Any two octave scale and its arpeggio detache whole bows.
- Any one octave scale and its arpeggio, demonstrating knowledge of flats, <u>slurred</u> two notes to a bow.
- 2. A **prepared piece** of music chosen to demonstrate technical and musical ability.
- 3. <u>All</u> of the prepared **excerpts of music** available online on Tuesday 24th October, and
- 4. A small piece of sight reading, to be worked through at the audition.

Remember to print, complete and bring the **Application Form** with you to the audition (available online at the above address)

Audition Decision Criteria:

- Accurate intonation
- Strong clear sound
- Spiccato bowing
- Accurate reading of rhythm, pitch and volume variation
- All assuming good, healthy, accurate posture and hold of the instrument and bow.

Additional skills:

- shifting for violins to 3rd position, 'cellos to 4th position.
- commencement of vibrato for violins, violas and 'cellos

Costs:

Membership cost for PSSO is \$55 per year.

Other costs include: the uniform polo top (\$48), a Country Concert Tour in Term 1.
